2. Obesity is a public health problem that has become a worldwide epidemic.

You perform a **test of significance** to assess whether the sample data provide evidence that more than 10% of all Sri Lankans are left-handed, and you calculate a **test statistic** of 3.7 and a **p-value** of 0.0001.
