 - 3.2. What are the investigations need to be requested for this patient? (30 Marks)
 - 3.3. Fine Needle Aspiration Cytology (FNAC) of lump is reported as papillary cell carcinoma of thyroid gland. Discuss the management plan of this patient (40 Marks)

4. A 54-year-old known asthmatic woman admitted to the emergency unit with wheezing and difficulty in breathing of 3 days duration. On examination, she is dyspnoeic and her respiratory rate is 42/min.

During your examination, you found that the patient is not properly using the MDI.

4.3. Explain, how will you educate the patient regarding the usage of MDI with spacer? (30 Marks)
