 - **1.4.** The medical officer ordered few blood investigations for this patient.

- 1.5. Write the nurses responsibility in collecting the specimen and transport (25 Marks)
- 2. A 55-year-old male was admitted to the medical ward with the history of fever for 3days, cough, and malaise and vomited three times on the day of admission. He is a known diabetes mellitus and hypertension patient. On admission the T- 101 F, P- 85 bpm, R 24 /min, BP- 150/90mmHg. RBS- 180mg/dl. Patient complains that he feels dizziness and body pain. As a nursing student you have been allocated this patient for providing nursing care on the day on admission.
